

What is it?

- JSEL (Jeffco Summer of Early Literacy) is a 6-week, intensive summer school program that focuses on increasing students' literacy skills.
- Each day, Kdgr. – 3rd grade students will have the same emphasis on reading and writing as they do during the school year.
- Students will work with licensed teachers and trained para-professionals.
- Students will be in a small group setting with no more than 15 students in each class.
- Students will experience educational, on-site assemblies and schools will host special family nights. Students will receive books to take home to keep, and more!

How is this available for my students?

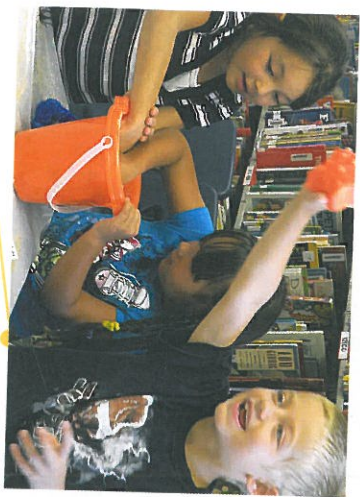

Who is eligible?

If your student:

- needs more support in Reading and/or Writing,
- is not currently at end-of-year benchmarks or is on a READ Plan,
- is being recommended by his/her teacher,
- is entering Kindergarten, First, Second or Third grade in the fall of 2017...

then, he or she is invited to participate!

Attendance?

- Parents must register their child(ren) by Friday, May 19, 2017 to participate in the Jeffco Summer of Early Literacy.
- Parents must commit to transporting their child(ren) to and from school each day – attendance is key!
- Parents must commit to supporting the JSEL program and engaging in family literacy activities, such as reading together or practicing writing.
- Students with perfect attendance will be entered into weekly drawings to win great prizes and family incentives!

What is the

cost?

The program is **FREE** to all families if their child is eligible to participate

Each school will serve a **FREE breakfast and lunch every day** to participating students and their siblings under age 18!
