Back to School Night

Our first opportunity to see you this year is at Back to School Night on Tuesday, August 13th from 5:00 - 7:30 pm. When you arrive, please go first to the gym for important all-school information from the admin team. (We have buses this year!) Afterwards, head to your child's classroom. Each teacher will host five, duplicate 20 minute sessions adhering to the following schedule. Class rosters will be posted on classroom doors to help you navigate. This night is an "eyes only" night, meaning students and siblings may not access any materials in the classroom. Phase In Day

All students new to Upper Elementary are invited to Phase In Day on Wednesday, August 14th. This is a required day for all 4th graders & any 5th graders new to FHM. We are looking forward to the opportunity to help the incoming students get acclimated to their new environment. All elementary teachers will be waiting outside on the elementary playground to greet students as they arrive. * There is no before or after care on Phase In Day! *

First Day of School

Upper elementary teachers will be joyously awaiting the arrival of all students on the blacktop from 8:00 - 8:15 am on Thursday, August 15th. This is a normal, full school day for all FHM students.

Upper Elementary Policies & Procedures

- Snack Students are able to eat a snack during morning work cycle.
 Please, send your child with a healthy, low-sugar snack every day!
- Water Bottle While students are able to utilize water fountains, we
 encourage you to send them with a water bottle each week that they
 can keep in the classroom.
- Homework Students will have weekly homework that includes a reading log, spelling words, math facts, journal entry, and practical life. After thoughtful consideration, we have decided to replace the long-term legacy homework projects with weekly homework.
 Students will still complete long term projects in class, and there will still be opportunities for families to see in-class presentations. Stay tuned for details.
- Personal Belongings (toys, jewelry, electronics) Toys are not allowed in the classroom. We are not responsible for the loss of any items brought to school.
- Personal Belongings (clothing, backpack, boots, etc) We strongly encourage you to label all of your child's possessions that come to school
- Volunteers FHM is revamping our volunteer model. Keep your eyes open for more info in September!
- Absence Procedure Attendance is critical to your child's success.
 Please call the attendance line at 303-982-0280 if your child must miss a day of school. Then, contact your teacher directly to determine the make-up work your child will need to complete. Due to the nature of Montessori, not all assignments can be made up at home.
- School Day Times (Elementary School): 8:15 a.m. 3:20 p.m.
 Doors are open from 8:00 8:10 a.m. Enter through elementary playground doors. * If you need to drop your child off before 8:00 am, they MUST be enrolled in before care. Unsupervised students ARE NOT PERMITTED on school grounds before 8:00 am; this is out of concern for the safety of your child! There are no adults outside before 8:00 am.
- Student Cell Phones If your student brings a phone/communication device, it will be checked in to the teacher and not accessible during the school day. If you need to contact your child, call the front office.
- Birthdays Each child can play a birthday game of their choice.

 Genius (click for link). Please, don't label these supplies as they are
 shared within the classroom and school community.
