Core Qualifications for Support Staff Positions:

Our support staff members bring varying levels of education and experience, but all share a common vision of supporting students to make their time at Free Horizon Montessori as positive and successful as possible. We value all members of our staff and believe in supporting professional growth for career advancement. Support Staff must at minimum possess a high school diploma, be at least 18 years of age, relate well to children and adults, and demonstrate an interest in and knowledge of children and concern for their proper care, education, and overall well-being. Candidates without an Associate's Degree or higher must pass a pre-employment basic skills assessment prior to hire. Colorado PDIS Level III or higher certificate required.

Position Description:

Early Childhood Educational Assistant & After Care (Ages 3 - 6) – Full Time, Full Benefits Eligible (9:30 am - 6:00 pm Monday - Friday; 8:00 am - 4:30 pm on Staff Development Days) – **EDUCATIONAL ASSISTANT:** This individual works under the direction of a Lead Teacher and under the supervision of the Instructional Coach in helping to plan and implement an educational, enjoyable, creative, and efficient environment conducive to supporting children in developing physically, emotionally, socially, and cognitively. The Educational Assistant is a vital asset to the Montessori classroom community who implements positive classroom management procedures, assists students with their class work, support students with conflict resolution, provides supportive instruction under the direction of the Lead Teacher, and models respectful and responsible behavior in order to guide children. The Educational Assistant is flexible, supports children in developing independence while also showing sensitivity to their needs, and is skilled in supporting the Lead Teacher in promoting a calm and peaceful learning environment. Our Educational Assistants are life-long learners who welcome feedback with grace and enthusiastically embrace opportunities to participate in recommended training programs, educational conferences, and other courses pertinent to professional growth. This person truly loves working with young children, and is committed to helping them build a solid educational foundation, developing strong social and emotional competency, and inspiring a life-long love of learning. **AFTER CARE:** This person works directly with the Program Coordinator to provide a safe and nurturing afterschool experience for our school's students. The optimal person for this position will be energetic, playful, organized, have a zest for learning, and a strong ability to work collaboratively with others in support of children. Our AC staff collaboratively plan and implement creative ideas to infuse the afterschool experience with unique, fun, safe, and engaging activities. Our After Care staff must meet qualifications as outlined under the Colorado Department of Human Services for Early Childhood Teacher (PDIS Level III or higher). Note that this is a mandatory requirement for the position. Seeking an individual who is equally comfortable working with Primary Early Childhood (preschool, pre-k, and kindergarten mixed-age) students.
