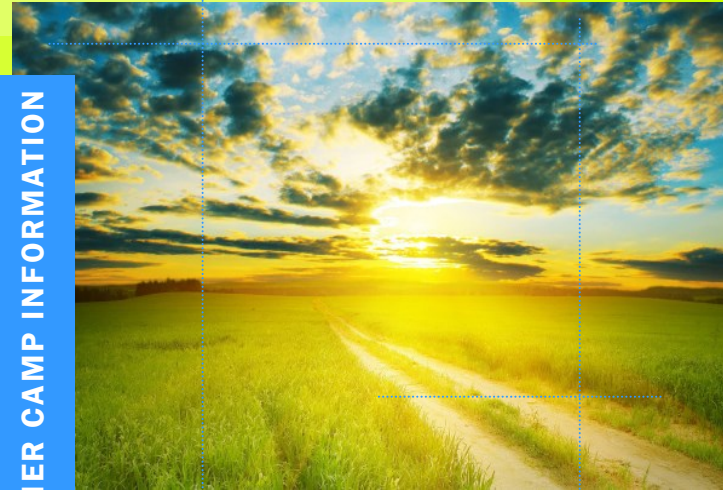

It's a splash! We'll have water play, water balloons, and a giant water pad, plus ocean and water art at FHM and a field trip to Surfside Spray Park.
- (4)  **Movin' and Groovin'/Action Reaction (June 26-30th):**  
Get your heart pumping as we run up and down a range of activities from sports to dance. Features a visit from JumpBunch!
- (5)  **Fun Frontier/Home on the Range (July 10-14th):**  
We'll get back to basics with History Colorado, learn how to make butter, and do some quilting, knitting and other textile work.
- (6)  **The Sound of Music/Musical Expression (July 5-7th):**  
We will make a variety of instruments, listen to many kinds of music, and enjoy a visit from Denver Brassical Adventures.
- (7)  **Fantastic Food/Cooking Capers (July 17-21st):**  
Healthy treats and baked goods galore! Students will experience food through cooking, sensory exploration and crafts, as well as making a variety of yummy snacks. Features a visit from Sticky Fingers Cooking!

# Come join the fun!

For Summer 2017, Free Horizon will be offering both 3-days and 5-days per session scheduling options. To accommodate field trip planning, all 3-day sessions will be Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday only, with the exception of July 5-7 (M-W only for all campers due to 4th of July holiday). One day per week, camp will include sprinkler and water play at FHM\*\*\*. Each week will include either an on-site, walking, or off-site field trip.

Additionally, families may select half-day or full-day time slots. **Prices below include an EARLY BIRD DISCOUNT!** Enroll by **Friday, March 3rd** to take advantage of this discounted rate!

**Half-day camp** (9am-1pm) includes all classroom programming, special activity and time for a sack lunch from home. Half-day campers do not receive a morning snack or a rest time.

- 3 Half Days per Week = \$140 for first enrolled child, \$130 for siblings
- 5 Half Days per Week = \$190 for first enrolled child, \$180 for siblings

**Full-day camp** (8am-4:30pm) includes all half-day activities, plus a nap time for 3- and 4-year-olds, outdoor play for older children and a morning and afternoon snack\*\*.

- 3 Full Days per Week = \$210 for first enrolled child, \$200 for siblings
- 5 Full Days per Week = \$290 for first enrolled child, \$280 for siblings

Enrollment forms are due with deposit by Thursday, April 27th, 2017. Payment for sessions 1-5 is due by May 1st, 2017. Registration forms, including medical history, immunization information and emergency contacts will be sent to the email address on the enrollment form. Registration paperwork and payment for sessions 6-9 are due by May 15th, 2017. Space is limited and priority will be given in order of enrollments received.
